At All Saints Catholic School, we deeply believe that Catholic education is a precious gift that should be accessible to all children, regardless of a family's financial situation. We are committed to ensuring that no child is ever denied an education due to financial barriers.

Through the generous support of donors to the Diocese of Lincoln's Good Shepherd Scholarship, as well as the contributions from All Saints Parish, we are able to keep tuition costs at a small fraction of the actual expense of educating each child. This is our way of ensuring that every child has the opportunity to grow in faith, knowledge, and character within our supportive community.

Actual Cost of Education for the 2024-25 school year
was \$6,578.00 per student.

All Saints Scholarship - available to every family K-6th grade that applies, not based on need, (up to \$650 per student)

Multi Student discount - families with more than one student in K-6th grades can receive discounted tuition, not based on need. (\$500 per students - for the second and additional students)

Active Parish Member - all active All Saints parish families, who embrace stewardship by sharing their time, talent and treasure are eligible for this discount. **Do not need to apply in FACTS.* (\$270 per student)

Guardian Angel Scholarship - if your family is within 225% to 400% of the Federal Poverty Level, you are eligible to apply. Also, available to families with special need circumstances. (preschool - 6th grade)

Diocesan scholarship

Good Shepherd scholarship - \$1,800 per qualified student. *See more info on next page*

The **Good Shepherd Scholarship** will continue in the 2026-2027 academic year in the amount of \$1,800 for grades K-8 and will cover families within 225% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Since the Good Shepherd Scholarship Program was announced in 2019, the Lincoln Diocese has awarded over \$12 million dollars in financial aid to families who attend Catholic Schools.

During the 2024-2025 academic year, the Good Shepherd Scholarship Program: • Awarded 1,447 student scholarships, totaling over \$17.1 million dollars • 22-25% of Catholic School students received Good Shepherd Scholarships • 100% Graduation Rate for senior scholarship recipients (84% Nebraska Rate, 85% U.S. Rate) • 30% of scholarship recipients were minorities

Good Shepherd Scholarship Program – 2025-2026

1. Good Shepherd Scholarships (GSS) are for students within 225% of Federal Poverty Level.
2. Families must apply in FACTS for all scholarships and submit 2024 or 2025 Tax Forms, including the 1040 and W-2.
3. The FACTS application is one \$45 fee for all scholarships, including GSS and local Catholic school scholarships. Any family may apply, regardless of religious affiliation.
4. Families must complete the FACTS Scholarship application each year in FACTS to be eligible for scholarships.
5. **Scholarship applications start January 1, 2026 and the deadline to complete the application is March 31, 2026.**
6. The definition of income follows the Federal Lunch Program guidelines (<https://www.fns.usda.gov/cn/eligibility-manual-school-meals>)

Scholarship Programs

Beginning in 2019 this diocesan-wide scholarship program has offered financial assistance to bridge the gap for families between tuition costs and their ability to pay. These Diocesan Scholarships were introduced to help low-income and middle-income families and to provide an additional source of scholarship funding for Catholic Schools. The Good Shepherd Scholarships is available to any student, regardless of their religious affiliation.

Tuition in the Diocese of Lincoln

Tuition assistance is available locally through every school in the Lincoln Diocese and every child receives a significant discount from the cost of education. This, however, still leaves over 2,000 children diocesan-wide who need additional financial assistance. The Good Shepherd Scholarship was introduced to support these families.

The Good Shepherd Scholarship has one mission, to ensure that Catholic education in the Diocese of Lincoln is available to any student, through financial assistance to families in need. In partnership with businesses, foundations and many benefactors, the Lincoln Diocese will continue its legacy of providing families with an excellent and affordable Catholic education for their children.
